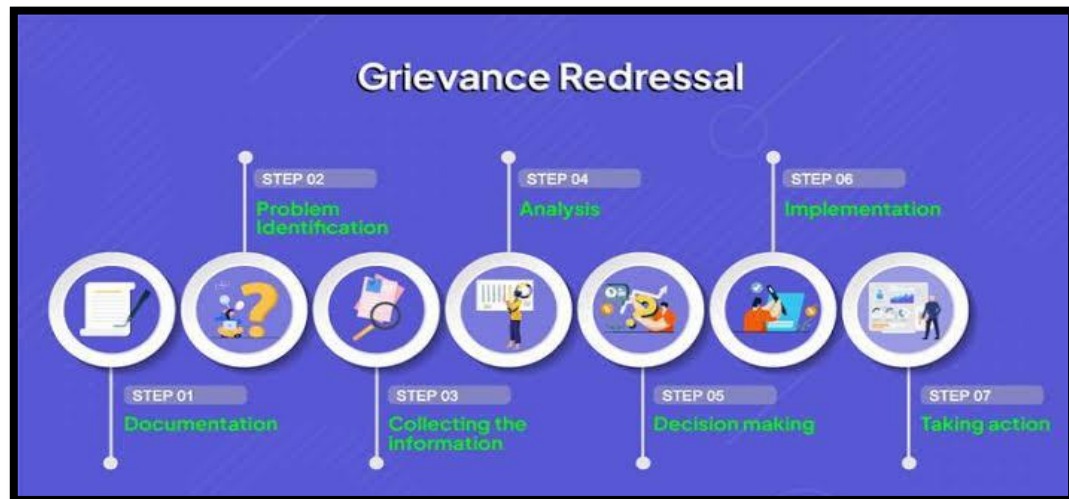
Patient Safety programme

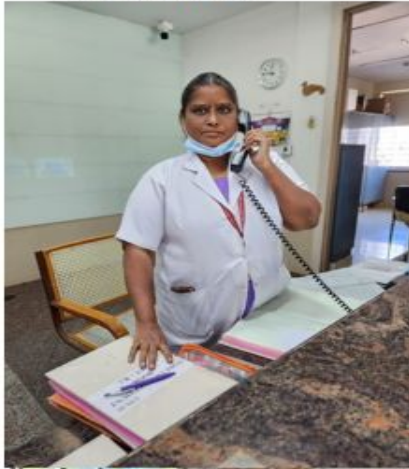

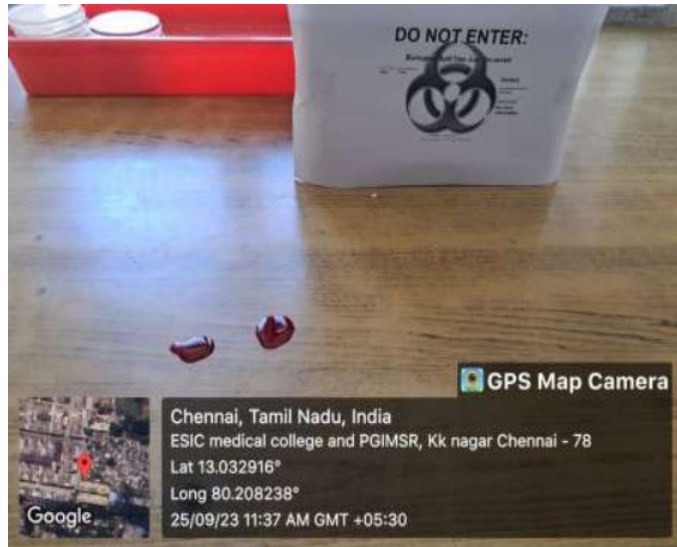
