"World No Tobacco Day Report 2024"

(15-days Activity from 20-05-2024 to 05-06-2024)

Theme: Protecting Children from Tobacco Industry Interference

1. Institution Details with logo: ESIC Dental College & Hospital, Kalaburagi, Karnataka.



2. Content: Best Performing Dental Colleges With Respect To WNTD Activities

3. Executive Summary:

The ESIC Dental College and Hospital, Kalaburagi, conducted a series of impactful activities to commemorate World No Tobacco Day (WNTD) 2024. These initiatives spanned from May 20 to June 5, focusing on cessation of tobacco use, and promoting oral cancer awareness.

Promotive, preventive, and screening outreach activities included oral cancer screening and awareness programs that benefitted many patients with oral cancer screening and referrals for further treatment. Intensive IEC activities involved the creation and display of 18 educational materials over 15 days, reaching 2856 patients. A special oral cancer screening campaign at OPD and TCC of the institute during 15 days of the activity helped many patients in and around Kalaburagi City.

Training and capacity-building programs were highlighted by a session for nursing students on oral cancer screening, enhancing their skills in early diagnosis. School-based initiatives included an awareness program for students focusing on the dangers of tobacco use and oral cancer.

Public engagement was further amplified through events, including a flash mob and public lectures, programs to raise awareness about tobacco use and its health implications. Pledge ceremonies involved 134 patients and all healthcare professionals of ESIC Dental College, emphasizing a commitment to a tobacco-free generation.

Social media campaigns across four platforms (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, WhatsApp) reached 458 followers, spreading awareness and updates about WNTD activities. Additional efforts included a flash mob that raised awareness among 120 attendees. A group discussion on the theme "protecting children from tobacco industry interference" involved faculty, junior residents, and students, promoting critical thinking and advocacy. Throughout these activities, 49 IEC materials were utilized, and four social media platforms were actively engaged, directly impacting thousands and underscoring ESIC Dental College's commitment to combating tobacco use and promoting oral health.

4. Activities under the following categories

1. Promotive, preventive and screening outreach activities

Description:

We conducted an oral cancer screening and awareness program on 30 May 2024 at Nandini Dairy Milk Union, Kalaburagi. A total of 41 patients attended the program. All patients underwent screening for oral pre and or cancerous lesions. A total of 22 patients were identified with a positive history of tobacco use and given health awareness regarding oral cancer at the campsite and referred to TCC for counseling. A total of 9 patients were identified with oral premalignant lesions and were referred to ESIC Dental College & Hospital for necessary treatment.

Under the same category, another oral cancer screening and awareness program was conducted on 3 June 2024 at Saptagiri Motors, Mahindra workshop in Kalaburagi. A total of 25 patients attended the program. Initially, an oral cancer awareness program was conducted using IEC materials prepared by the students. All patients underwent screening for oral pre and or cancerous lesions. A total of 16 patients were identified with positive history of tobacco use and 7 patients were identified with oral premalignant lesions and were referred to ESIC Dental College & Hospital for necessary treatment.

2. **IEC Activities**


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
As a part of this category, dental undergraduate students, interns, and junior residents were involved in preparing IEC materials related to WNTD. All the students actively participated and prepared various IEC materials. These include 8 posters, 10 placards. The materials were related to various aspects of tobacco use and oral cancer. All the IEC materials were displayed on the college premises during 15 days of WNTD observance. Many patients attending the OPD showed interest in IEC materials.



3. Oral Cancer Screening Activities

Description:

The Department of Public Health Dentistry in association with Oral Medicine and Radiology of ESIC Dental College, Kalaburagi conducted oral cancer screening activities over 15 days from 20-05-2024 to 05-06-2024. A total of 2856 patients attending the OPD during the period underwent screening for oral pre and or cancerous lesions. Patients with a positive history of tobacco use were provided with health awareness regarding tobacco use and oral cancer and were referred to TCC for counseling.

Also, the TCC Cell of ESIC Dental College, Kalaburagi played a key role. About 107 patients with a positive history of smoking form of tobacco use identified at OPD were referred to TCC and Carbon Monoxide Levels were assessed and nicotine dependence was assessed. All the patients were provided with necessary tobacco cessation counseling methods depending on the TCC case history proforma.

4. Training and Capacity Building Programs

Description:

On 28 May 2024, a training session was conducted for nursing students of ESIC Nursing College, Kalaburagi on Oral Cancer Screening. A total of 87 students attended the program. Dr. Gadde Praveen, Associate Professor, Dept. of Public Health Dentistry conducted the session. He trained students on how to identify oral premalignant or malignant lesions in their early stages and explained various risk factors for it. The program was conducted from 3 to 4: 45 pm at the Auditorium of ESIC Medical College. The principal, ESIC Nursing College, and the students were very satisfied with the training program.

A total of 56 students attended the session. The program was very much appreciated by students and the management.


8. Pledge ceremony by healthcare professionals


9. Social media activity

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
