Union Minister holds Press Conference on Achievements of 9 Years of the Ministry of Labour & Employment



Addressing a press conference on achievements of 9 years of the Ministry of Labour & Employment in New Delhi he said that the country is now changing, reforming, simplifying labour laws. Shri Yadav said with this in mind 29 labour laws have been converted into 4 simple labour codes. He said this will ensure empowerment of workers via minimum wages, job security,

social security and health security. Union Minister said that in the last 9 years India has done a lot for work in both unorganised and organised sectors, under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi.







Shri Yadav highlighted various flagship schemes meant for welfare for workers such as e-Shram Portal, National Career Service (NCS), Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana (ABRY), Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Mandhan Scheme (PM-SYM) and how these schemes have benefited workers.



He further said that the e-Shram portal is one of the key initiatives to create a national data base for unorganised workers. A total of 28.93 crore unorganised workers have registered on the portal in more than 400 occupations. More occupation will be added. e-Shram portal is also integrated with NCS and Skill India Portal (SIP) portal.

The Union Minister mentioned National Career Service (NCS) was Launched in 2015 to provide a variety of employment related services on digital platforms. He said as on 31.05.2023, the NCS

platform has 3.20 crore registered Jobseekers, 11.25 Lakh active employers and 6.42 lakh active vacancies. He said vacancies mobilized since its launched are more than 1.39 Crore. It is integrated with e-Shram, Udyam and Skill India Portal (SIP), he added.Shri Yadav said Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) linked Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana (ABRY) was launched on 30.12.2020 with an expenditure of 22,810 Crore for the period i.e. FY 2020-2024 to boost employment generation and to minimize socio-economic impact of Covid-19 pandemic.

He said as on 30.05.2023, 1,52,278 establishments have claimed benefits amounting to 9382.16 Crores in respect of 60.40 Lakh beneficiaries.

Shri Yadav said around 44.33 lakh beneficiaries have been enrolled under the Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Mandhan Scheme (PM-SYM) as on 31.05.2023 which was launched on 15th February, 2019 assuring minimum monthly pension of Rs. 3000/- after the age of 60 years to the workers of unorganized sector.

The Union Minister said Shram Suvidha Portal (SSP) was Launched on 16th October, 2014 to promote effective, efficient and real-time governance by bringing transparency and accountability in labour laws, easing compliance and reducing transaction costs. Also integrated with the National Single Window System Portal (NSWS) of DPIIT, it enables investors to apply for licenses and registrations under labour laws on single sign-on at NSWS, he added.









Shri Yadav also highlighted various policy reforms such as decriminalization under Labour codes, Maternity Benefit, Welfare for SC/ST job seekers and Labour welfare scheme for Beedi/cine/Non-Coal Mines workers, in the last 9 years. He said notified paid maternity leave was increased from 12 weeks to 26 weeks for two surviving children and 12 weeks for more than two children. Commissioning / Adopting Mothers' are getting 12 weeks of paid maternity leave for the first time, he added.

The Union Minister also highlighted major developments in ESIC in the last nine years. Numbers of districts covered under ESI Scheme increased from 393 in 2014 to 611. Insured Persons

and beneficiaries are 3.10 crore and 12.03 crore respectively, at present compared to 2.03 crore IPs and 7.89 crore beneficiaries in 2014. Number of hospitals increased from 151 in 2014 to 161, similarly, dispensaries also increased from 1418 to 1502. No. of Medical colleges are 8 presently as compared to 4 in 2014. Number of MBBS seats increased from 400 in 2014 to 950 at present. Number of MD/MS seats increased from 60 in 2014 to 275. DNB broad specialty seats are 81 now, whereas there was no seat in 2014.In 2019 contribution rate reduced to 4% from 6.5%. Future expansion of ESIC include 89 new hospitals with additional 10120 beds and 202 new dispensaries.

In last 9 years labour policy reforms have ensured empowerment of workers providing minimum wages, job security, social security and health security

MEETING OF STATE/UT LABOUR SECRETARIES HELD IN AGRA, UTTAR PRADESH

Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India organized a meeting with States/UTs Labour and Employment Secretaries at Agra, Uttar Pradesh from 29th June – 30th June, 2023. Additional Chief Secretary/Principal Secretaries/Secretaries/Commissioners of Labour/Employment from 28 States/UTs participated in the meeting. Ms. Arti Ahuja, Secretary, Ministry of

Labour & Employment, Government of India, chaired the meeting. Shri Ramesh Krishnamurthi, Additional Secretary, Labour & Employment, Shri Alok Chandra, Senior Labour & Employment Adviser, Dr. Rajendra Kumar, Director General, ESIC along with other officials from Ministry of Labour & Employment and its organizations participated in the meeting.



Secretary, Ministry of labour and Employment, while welcoming the participants to the meeting, explained the objectives of this meeting, namely, to discuss important issues relating to the welfare of the workers, including those in unorganized sector such as migrant workers, BOC Workers, SoP for Shramik Chaupal to reach-out to workers at their doors, integration of various portals & sharing of data, conduct of job fairs under National Career Service and increasing enrolments in PMSYM.







Shri Amit Nirmal, DDG (Employment), Ministry of Labour & Employment, made presentations on E-Shram Portal and NCS portal. Shri Kamal Kishore Soan, Joint Secretary, MoLE made presentations on PMSYM and BOCW, seeking inputs from States on ensuring welfare of migrants. The presentations were followed

by suggestions of States/UTs. The day also saw discussions on various issues relating to workers like SoP for Shramik Chaupal, integration of E-Shram with State Portals & sharing of data, integration of National NCS with State employment portals, conduct of job fairs under NCS.



ESIC related issues like, land for hospitals/dispensaries, functioning of ESIS hospitals, Construction of ESIC/ESIS hospitals, maintenance of Annual Repair Maintenance and Service Repair works of ESIS hospitals, ESIS State Society, utilization of OAP, implementation of Dhanwantri, etc. were discussed in detail. Director General, ESIC inter-alia requested States to utilize ESIS hospitals, under the State Governments, whose bed occupancy are poor, in a better manner.

Secretary, Ministry of Labour & Employment stressed on the

need for taking collective efforts to cover the workers uncovered so far with social security coverage in both the organized sector and unorganized sector. The Secretary launched a Dashboard for State Nodal Officers in NCS Portal during this meeting. A presentation on digital mapping of 3193 offices/establishments under Ministry of Labour & Employment, was also made during the meeting.

The meeting was also utilized for discussing other issues related to States/UTs and Central Government, including best practices.








EXPANSION OF ESI SCHEMES' COVERAGE TO 611 DISTRICTS OF THE COUNTRY

PROVISIONAL PAYROLL DATA OF ESIC FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2023

The provisional payroll data of ESIC reveals that 17.88 lakh new employees have been added in the month of April, 2023. Around 30,249 new establishments have been registered and brought under the social security umbrella of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation in the month of April, 2023, thus ensuring more coverage.

Data evidently reveals that more jobs have been generated for the youth of the nation as out of the total 17.88 lakh employees added during the month, 8.37 lakh employees up to the age of 25 years constitute the bulk of new registrations, which is 47% of the total employees.

Gender-wise analysis of payroll data indicates that enrolment of net female members has been 3.53 lakh in April, 2023.
