The 3rd Graduation Day / Convocation Ceremony of ESIC Medical College & Hospital, K. K. Nagar, Chennai, marked the achievements of the 2017 MBBS batch, showcasing the impact of ESIC's efforts in medical education field.

ESIC observed Special Fortnight on millets, aligned with the International Year of Millets-2023. This initiative, spanning from 01.07.2023 - 14.07.2023 was aimed to raise awareness about the nutritional benefits of millets across all our hospitals.

G20 LABOUR & EMPLOYMENT MINISTERS MEETING 2023 CONCLUDED IN INDIA

The two day G20 Labour and Employment Ministers Meeting 2023 concluded in Indore successfully with unanimous adoption of three G20 Outcome Documents which are G20 Policy Priorities on Strategies to Address Skill Gaps Globally, G20 Policy Priorities on Adequate and Sustainable Social Protection and Decent Work for Gig and Platform Workers and G20 Policy Options for Sustainable Financing of Social Protection. These documents will be submitted to the Leaders for their consideration to be annexed to the G20 New Delhi Leader's Declaration 2023. The Ministers also adopted the Outcome Document and the Chair's Summary. Addressing a Press Conference Union Minister for Labour and Employment and Environment, Forest and Climate Change Shri Bhupender Yadav said the Labour & Employment Ministers' meeting took a historical step closer to strengthen global amity. He said under India's Presidency, the G20 nations have agreed to include the reference to 'respect for multilateralism', 'respect for purposes and principles of the UN Charter', as well as the phrase by our Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi 'Today's era must not be of war'. He added this is a testament to the commitment of all G20 countries to come together for ensuring decent work and labour welfare for all workers.

There was participation from 176 plus Delegates, including 26 Ministers from G20 Member and Guest countries. There was participation from 15 Heads and Representatives of International Organizations, namely OECD, ISSA, ILO, and World Bank.

Four Employment Working Group (EWG) meetings, chaired by Ms. Arti Ahuja, Secretary, MoL&E, were held successfully in Jodhpur, Guwahati, Geneva and Indore. The Indore meeting held on 19.07.2023 & 20.07.2023 was the fourth and final EWG meeting. Apart from that, numerous bilateral meetings were also held between India and other G20 countries. The EWG deliberated and negotiated on three priority areas selected by the







Indian Presidency, namely: Addressing global skill gaps; Gig and platform economy and social protection; and Sustainable financing of social protection.

The State Government organized a delightful cultural evening showcasing Madhya Pradesh's rich traditional performing

arts for the Ministers and delegates, at the Welcome Dinner at the Sheraton Grand Palace, Indore on 20th July, 2023. The L20 and B20 submitted a joint statement on their work and ideas to advance labour welfare, while the IOE addressed the august assembly.



The G20 took note of the overwhelming success story of India in accelerating the transition from informality to formality and enhancing social protection as India's recent key initiatives in

legal reforms, systemic transformation, Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, and social protection were highlighted.







Social partners represented by G20 engagement groups, namely Business 20, Labour 20, Startup 20 and Think 20 called for

greater coordination and synergies between all stakeholders to address global labour challenges.



The LEM meeting and EWG's journey under India's Presidency concluded with the adoption of the Chair's Summary and Outcome Documents. Adoption and implementation of these outcomes will enable people, especially India's youth to avail gainful

employment across the world leading to sustainable, resilient and inclusive global economic development. These outcomes reflect and have the potential to fulfill the aspirations of millions in the G20 countries and beyond.







The EWG adopted 'G20 Policy Priorities on Adequate and Sustainable Social Protection and Decent Work for Gig and Platform Workers'. In a significant breakthrough for the gig and

platform economy, the Indian Presidency forged consensus in the G20 for providing social protection to the gig and platform workers on priority, irrespective of their classification.



India championed the cause of these workers by bringing the G20 together to agree to work towards sharing of responsibility among governments, employers and workers for providing adequate and sustainable social protection for these workers.

The 3rd Graduation Day / Convocation Ceremony for the 2017 batch of ESIC Medical College & Hospital, K. K. Nagar, Chennai was held on 14.07.2023. Shri Bhupender Yadav, Union Minister

for Labour & Employment and Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India was the Chief Guest.

Shri Rameswar Teli, Minister of State for Labour & Employment and Petroleum & Natural Gas, Govt. of India, in his address emphasized that ESIC is committed to deliver top-quality medical care and comprehensive social security to the workforce.

The MoS also urged the doctors to treat patients not only with the knowledge that they possess but also with empathy.

ESIC Medical College & Hospital, K. K. Nagar, Chennai

 ESIC Medical College & Hospital, K. K. Nagar was established by the Govt. of Tamil Nadu as an ESIS Hospital 1977, subsequently, taken over by ESIC, in 1991 to function as ESIC Model Hospital.

- The sprawling hospital campus is spread over an area of 13 acres.
- In 2011, the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences & Research (PGIMSR) was established and in 2013, the MBBS curriculum for 100 annual admissions was introduced. Subsequently, the annual Intake has been increased to 125 in 2020 wherein 25 seats are allocated for Wards of Insured Persons. Intake has been further increased to 150 from the academic year 2023-2024.
- Presently, there are 27 PG seats in 8 Broad Specialties.
 Further, the Institute has obtained in principle approval from the affiliating University to start PG courses in six more disciplines namely, Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry,





Pharmacology, Community Medicine and Ophthalmology. (2 Seats in each Specialty).

- The graduating batch of 2017 had an intake of 99 students with 19 students admitted under Wards of IP Quota.
- Super Specialty services are provided in Endocrinology, Cardiology, Cardio Thoracic Vascular Surgery, Neurology, Neuro Surgery, Nephrology, Medical Gastroenterology, Urology, Plastic surgery, Vascular surgery, Pediatric surgery, Oncology (Medical & Surgical), Interventional Radiology, Rheumatology, Reproductive Medicine. In house diagnostic services like USG, CT Scan, MRI, X ray, Colour Doppler, VDRL, and IVP are available under one roof.
- ESIC MCH K. K. Nagar, Chennai is functioning as Mentor Institution for the ESIC Hospitals in the State of Tamil Nadu

- and Kerala under the Hub & Spokes Model. As a hub, the institution will provide tele-consultation services to the patients of Spokes Hospitals in Super Specialties and Broad Specialties. The institute also takes Capacity Building Measures for the spokes hospitals in various challenge areas and enhances the skills of the Medical officers and Healthcare workers.
- Occupational Diseases Centre receives patients from Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Karnataka, Telangana and Puducherry: These insured persons, working in various hazardous industries/ factories where they are exposed to various types of vapours, dusts, fumes and gases. Since its inception ODC (South zone) has evaluated more than 250 cases of occupational diseases.








AADHAAR SEEDING DRIVE

The demographic details will be captured for the new Employee/ Pensioner through the e-KYC process of UIDAI and for the existing ESIC Employee & ESIC Pensioner; the demographic details will be validated through the e-KYC process. The Aadhaar/ VID number will be authenticated through OTP/ Biometric authentication (using Fingerprint or Iris).




The purpose of seeding the Aadhaar/ VID and display the Aadhaar Status in ESIC Panchdeep Application & the benefits of implementation of Aadhaar using e-KYC and Aadhaar/ VID authentication through OTP/ Biometric are mentioned as below-

- To prevent fraudulent activities in financial transactions.
- To merge the contribution of a duplicate Insured person.
- To perform the De-duplication process and prevent the duplicate IP number generation.
- To perform the e-KYC; post e-KYC system will have the UIDAI verified demographic details of the beneficiaries.
- To authenticate the beneficiaries at the time of service delivery.


















PROVISIONAL PAYROLL DATA OF ESIC RELEASED FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 2023

The provisional payroll data of ESIC reveals that 20.23 lakh new employees have been added in the month of May, 2023. Around 24,886 new establishments have been registered and brought under the social security umbrella of the Employees' State Insurance Corporation in the month of May, 2023, thus ensuring more coverage.

Data evidently reveals that more jobs have been generated for the youth of the nation as out of the total 20.23 lakh employees added during the month, 9.40 lakh employees up to the age group of

25 years constitute the majority of new registrations which is 47% of the total employees.

Gender-wise analysis of payroll data indicates that net enrolment of female members has been 3.96 lakh in May, 2023. The data shows that a total 71 transgender employees have also got registered under ESI Scheme in the month of May 2023. It shows that ESIC is committed to deliver its benefits to every section of the society.


